ABIDE #1: GOOD SHEPHERD: John 10: 11-18

Last week Rev Mark Schultz invited us to reflect upon our experiences of being a part of The Vines UC. The leaders' team would love you to express your views on some key questions which are included in today's Grapevine.

Today we commence our ABIDE series, a chance to consider amidst the chaos of last year, how our faith is going, and more particularly our understanding and experience of what it is to ABIDE.

The hymn that automatically hits the topic is the often used funeral hymn, "Abide with me", a slow and reflective tune that affirms God's love in our final days. But what about the rest of our days?

Is it possible to UN-ABIDE?

What happens then?

To help us consider this and other questions we will be looking at our relationship with Jesus the Good Shepherd.

Q. Why do sheep need shepherds?

A. Because they get themselves into trouble.

So if we are sheep getting ourselves in trouble and in need of Jesus the Good Shepherd, what parallels are there for us today, particularly if Jesus calls our name and we don't listen! Or does going our own way make a difference to our faith journey?

Does being a child of God mean that once a part of the flock, always a part of the flock? If that is the case, what impacts does that have on Abiding?
