**to 30<sup>th</sup> September**

September offerings were \$7557 which is \$2300 below the monthly average for the 2022 budget. Projected to the end of the year this will mean a budget shortfall in annual offerings of about \$2500.

Income from the manse rental has been affected by 3 flooding issues due to our recent heavy rains. Emergency repairs have been attended. The Manse Task Group is currently working through these and other maintenance issues. We are now preparing the budget for 2023 and this will be presented to the congregation before the end of November.
